

**Merrill Warkentin** is the James J. Rouse Endowed Professor of Information Systems in the College of Business at Mississippi State University. His research, primarily on the impacts of organizational, contextual, and dispositional influences on individual behaviors in the context of information security and privacy and in social media, has appeared in *MIS Quarterly*, *Journal of MIS*, *Journal of the AIS*, *European Journal of Information Systems*, *Information Systems Journal*, *Information & Management*, *Decision Sciences*, *Decision Support Systems*, and others. He is the author or editor of seven books, and has authored or co-authored over 300 published manuscripts, including over 85 peer-reviewed journal articles. His work has been cited almost 14,000 times (h-index = 33) and he was recently ranked #20 in the world in AIS-6 Senior Scholar Basket journal articles published 2015-2017. He serves or has served in editorial roles for *MIS Quarterly*, *Information Systems Research*, *Journal of the AIS*, *Decision Sciences*, *European Journal of Information Systems*, *Information & Management*, and other journals. He is the Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Intellectual Capital*. He has held officer and other leadership positions at AIS, DSI, IFIP, and ACM. His work has been funded by NATO, NSF, NSA, DoD, Homeland Security, IBM, and others. He has chaired several international conferences and was the Program Co-Chair for the 2016 AIS Americas Conference on Information Systems (AMCIS).
