

Merrill Warkentin is the James J. Rouse Professor of Information Systems in the College of Business at Mississippi State University. His research, primarily on the impacts of organizational, contextual, and dispositional influences on individual behaviors in the context of information security and privacy, has appeared in *MIS Quarterly*, *Decision Sciences*, *Journal of Management Information Systems*, *Journal of the Association for Information Systems*, *European Journal of Information Systems*, *Information Systems Journal*, *Information & Management*, *Decision Support Systems*, and others. He is the author or editor of seven books, and has authored or co-authored about 300 published manuscripts, including over 75 peer-reviewed journal articles. He serves or has served as Associate Editor of *MIS Quarterly*, *Information Systems Research*, *Decision Sciences*, *European Journal of Information Systems*, *Information & Management*, and other journals. He is Senior Editor of the *AIS Transactions on Replication Research* and Eminent Area Editor (MIS) for *Decision Sciences*. He has held officer and other leadership positions at AIS, DSI, IFIP, and ACM. His work has been funded by NATO, NSF, NSA, DoD, Homeland Security, IBM, and others. He has chaired several international conferences and was the Program Co-Chair for the 2016 AIS Americas Conference on Information Systems (AMCIS).
